Dear Mass Servers and Parents:

Enclosed you will find the Mass Server Schedule through the rest of the year. I remind you that you are expected to come at least 10 minutes before Mass time to get vested and make sure the candles are lighted and everything is on the credence table.

There should be at least two (2) servers at the 7:30 Mass, and three (3) at all the other Masses. Again we are blessed with a full roster of servers; so when additional servers are assigned ALL are expected to do something by dividing the duties. On the other hand, you ARE EXPECTED to fill in whenever we are short handed.

Please remember to remove the Sacramentary and stand at the Sign of Peace except at the Spanish Mass. When the priests and the Eucharistic ministers are distributing Communion, remove the chalice, purificator and corporal. At the 9:30 Mass leave the corporal because the pyxes are on it. After Mass remove the corporal and the corporal that was under the cups. Also remember to extinguish the candles.

We need volunteers for the following special days. Please call the rectory as soon as possible lest you forget.
