- 3. Support Immigrants through "Stamp Out Despair Campaign"***

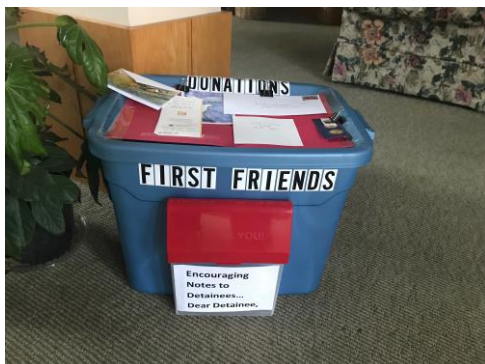


- Blank 2- Pocket Folders (no metal tabs)
- Size # 10 (business size) envelopes **stamped** with Forever Postage Stamps
- Writing paper (small size)
- Note pads, Blank note cards
- Greeting Cards (Including Christmas Cards)
- Soft Cover Books (Non-Violent) (Spanish & English)
- Stick Pens (No metal inserts)
- Money orders, \$20 each for commissary
- Board games & puzzles

4. Support Immigrants Released from Detention:

- Donate Used Smart Phones, Gift Cards: ShopRite, Whole Foods, Visa/MasterCard, Walmart, Target
- Volunteer to help with transportation, overnight hospitality

5. Contact Your Representative , Attend Weekly Vigils and Demand the End of Family Separation and Detention
